- Documents and processes delivery returns ensuring merchandise is returned to stock or to the supplier.
- Ensures inventory adjustment sheets are updated.
- Completes the forklift inspection form.
- Ensures all lifts are piled evenly with no leans and compliant with safety standards.
- Works with yard and warehouse teams to ensure stock is properly rotated.
- Maintains a clean and orderly yard and warehouse as directed.
- Performs other job-related duties as required including but not limited to snow plowing, container moving, yard maintenance and any other specialized moves that would require heavy equipment.
